From the General Manager ARK RFI

We are progressing well on the New Sand Bunker Project. We intentionally started as early in the year as possible to achieve a mid-June 2022 completion date. We have, as expected, lost some time due to snow and frigid temperatures, but we are confident we are still on track.

Once the project finishes in June, there will still be another month or so for the last 3 or 4 holes to grow in the new sod.

The *very important* part of this whole project is the respectful co-operation between members, golf staff, superintendent, and our contractor. We will continue to re-iterate the rules during construction and we strongly state that members must follow the direction of the Golf Staff and Superintendent until the end of the project. The rules are simple and consistent.

**A**. If there are no tee markers and no flag in the hole at the green, the hole is closed. DO NOT hit any balls on this hole and proceed to the next hole.

**B.** If the hole is open and there is brown gravel in the new sand trap, DO NOT step foot into any part of the sand trap. Leave your ball in the trap and play another ball per the instructions the golf shop has established.

**C.** The new sod is very noticeable from the existing turf. We have signage up where we are growing in new sod. DO NOT drive your cart over the new turf until the signs are down and the golf shop says the hole is fully open.

So, *please* help us assure that this project is very successful and that the course looks amazing when our contractor is finished. We won't be successful if damage is done, and we have to pay the contractor extra funds to repair it. For those who do not heed the golf shops instructions and we become aware that they caused damage, we will apply the costs of repair to the member's account.

I write this in a straight-forward manner, although with the most respectful tone, because we have just had our first nice days of March and I am told of multiple incidents of walking in newly sprayed polymer in the bunkers and driving on freshly laid sod. Some of the incidents occurred right after the Superintendent reminded the players of the rules. This cannot continue.

Thank you in advance for your continued support and care of the golf course.

As most of you are aware, as of March 1st you can begin posting active season scores played at Lakewood Oaks to your GHIN handicap. Please visit the USGA website or contact the golf shop for any clarification on specific questions you have about GHIN handicaps (Rules of Handicapping (usga.org).

#### A FEW THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND:

- Even if you play the ball up due to course conditions, you still post that score
- Even if bunkers are out of play for numerous holes during a round, you still post that score
- If a hole is completely closed during any given round, take par plus handicap on that hole, and you still post your score

By the time this article reaches you, holes #6 and #5 should be completed with sod and white sand, and will be entering the grow-in stage. Hole #4 will hopefully be ready for the polymer to be sprayed and potentially ready for sand and sod. Holes #2 and #3 are shaped and ready for coring at the time I am writing this article. Please pay attention to the signage on the course, because if you happen to walk into a bunker that has been freshly sprayed with the polymer it will cost you a new pair of shoes and the viability of that bunker in the long run.
