

Turf Tip steve griesinger, golf course superintendent

As we approach opening day, I want to remind membership that the course will be closed Monday & Tuesday, March 27th and 28th for aerification. It's a necessary step to ensure the greens become healthy and grow strong roots before play takes off.

From the USGA Experts: "Aeration is an essential program to keep playing surfaces healthy and in good condition. Aeration primarily is performed to control organic matter – i.e., decaying roots and grass stems – relieve soil compaction, stimulate root growth and improve drainage. If organic matter becomes too thick, it acts like a sponge and holds water at the surface after rain or irrigation. Excessive organic matter also inhibits root growth, reduces oxygen levels in the soil, encourages disease and eventually can lead to turf failure. Furthermore, excessive organic matter creates soft surfaces prone to ball marks, foot printing and inconsistent playing conditions. Aeration and topdressing are the most effective ways to control organic matter and maintain smooth, firm putting surfaces."
