

Acceptable Scoring

As of March 1, Lakewood went back into active score posting season. Please post all acceptable scores.

Minimum Number of Holes Played for Score to be Acceptable

For an 18-hole Score

For an 18-hole score to be acceptable for handicap purposes, a minimum of 10 holes must be played.

For a 9-hole Score

For a 9-hole score to be acceptable for handicap purposes, all 9 holes must be played. If a player has not played at least 9 holes, the score is not acceptable for handicap purposes.

For a more in depth look into Acceptability of Scores, take a look at this section from the USGA Handicap Rules Handbook.

HOW TO POST WHEN HOLE(S) NOT PLAYED

So, if your round is cut short because of something like darkness or weather, how do you tell if it will still count toward your Handicap Index?




Turf Tip STEVE GRIESINGER, GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENT

As we approach opening day, I want to remind membership that the course will be closed Monday and Tuesday, March 25 and 26 for aerification. It's a necessary step to ensure the greens become healthy and grow strong roots before play takes off.



From the USGA Experts: "Aeration is an essential program to keep playing surfaces healthy and in good condition. Aeration primarily is performed to control organic matter – i.e., decaying roots and grass stems – relieve soil compaction, stimulate root growth and improve drainage. If organic matter becomes too thick, it acts like a sponge and holds water at the surface after rain or irrigation. Excessive organic matter also inhibits root growth, reduces oxygen levels in the soil, encourages disease and eventually can lead to turf failure. Furthermore, excessive organic matter creates soft surfaces prone to ball marks, foot printing and inconsistent playing conditions. Aeration and topdressing are the most effective ways to control organic matter and maintain smooth, firm putting surfaces."
