

LPOA Athletic Field Rules and Regulations

1. Residents wishing to reserve the Lakewood Fields for Athletic teams must have at least 2 Lakewood residents on the team to make the reservation. If the Coach is a Lakewood resident, this counts towards the two resident requirements. As with any Common Ground usage, the LPOA Members must be in good standing with the association.
2. A maximum of two reservations per individual or team only. However, a team may practice at any time the field is open as long as the field is relinquished if a team with a reservation shows up. Outside of the reserved times, all fields are on a first come, first serve basis.
3. If a Coach is not a Lakewood Resident, he or she may also make 2 reservations for the team as long as 2 residents are on the team.
4. If a team with the reservation is not practicing on a given night, they may allow another team (two Lakewood residents requirement) to practice on that field.
5. The fields that are reserved are as follows: Baseball Field #1, #2, #3, and Soccer Field #1, #2, and #3. Baseball fields #1, 2, and 3 are located at the north end of the 23 acre park between Lake Drive and Lee's Summit Road. Soccer field #1 is at the St. Andrews Playground, #2 is at East Lake Village, and #3 is on Lake Drive across from the Cove Clubhouse.
6. The times for reservations are as follows: Monday-Friday from 5:00-6:30PM and from 6:30-8:00PM. On Saturday and Sunday, the fields are available from 8:00AM to 8:00PM. Each reservation will be for 1 ½ hours. If at any time there is someone on the baseball field during your reserved time call Community Service at 816-373-1500 and the Staff Member on duty will assist you. Please make sure you have proof of your reservation and a valid Lakewood ID with you at all times.
