



Club Rules & Regulations have recently been updated with Member Code & Conduct. The Golf Committee is requesting that all Members please review, sign and return the acknowledgment page to me or the Proshop. The Club Rules & Regulations can be found *here* or under Member Central>Forms.

We have some different options for our members to save 20% on their monthly dues with our Challenger and Champion programs. The Challenger program is available to members coming off a new member promotion and with a \$1000 initiation fee will get 20% off regular dues only for 3 years. Golf Like a Pro

We are still experiencing some minor hardware and software issues with GPS on the carts, but overall the Pace Technology GPS system is fully installed. Our next step is to optimize the geofences on the golf course. Due to drift from solar storms, we cannot be pinpoint accurate in our positioning of those perimeters. As we continue to collect data and adjust please let us know if your cart shuts off somewhere that you think it should not have so that we can adjust that area.

There are a few additional capabilities of the system that we will be adding over the next month. Now that we are back to having one cup on each green, staff will begin using the TRUPIN device to accurately mark hole locations each day. This data will automatically update with GPS so that members and guests will have yardages to the flagstick and not just the center of the green. We will also be adding a menu for St. Andrews Pub so that you can order from the golf course and have your food ready for you when you get to the Pub.

It is already very apparent that the benefits of these GPS units far and away outweigh any slight inconveniences that they may cause. Please contact the golf shop if you have a question about or experience a problem related to the GPS in your cart.



Turf Tip STEVE GRIESINGER, GOLF COURSE SUPERINTENDENT

April is a dicey month for warm season turf grass. With unusually warm February and March temperatures, the zoysia grass can take a hit as it is starting to transition out of dormancy too early. Therefore, if we happen to catch a late snow and/or hard freeze, dissection will likely happen, so let us hope this is not the case.

Since we moved Number 12 tee box back to its original location, it has allowed us to mow down a nice area to create a zoysia nursery in front of the old 12-tee box, which we did last year. Now that is ready we are able to cut and use our own sod to correct some more thin areas in the fairways. This is a big savings and benefit of not having to buy sod, since we are in control of the height of cut and agronomic practices and we can lay it a little earlier not having to wait on sod farms. Since there was several areas on 13, carts will remain on the path until we can actually mow those areas a couple of time. So please be cognizant of all the sodded areas that are marked with your carts. Thank you!
