Two things that every golfer should know before playing a round; where is the first tee and what is the course record? Well the answer to the second question isn't always that easy. Most clubs have a competitive course record as well as an unofficial course record. At Lakewood we have two players that share the unofficial course record (round was played under USGA rules, but not in a competition). PGA Tour member Robert Streb broke the old course record that stood for 20 plus years three seasons ago shooting 61. Current member and MGA Club Champion Marck de Lautour matched that round shooting a 61 in



July. Marck's round contained 11 birdies and one bogey. That lone bogey on Hole #17 was the only 5 on his scorecard. One month later Marck shot 65 during the Club Championship and while we do not have history on the competitive course record, he might also hold that record. Hopefully, some members join Marck in the quest for 59 out here at Lakewood!

Course Update

Rough and green bank renovations will be beginning at the end of the month continuing through October with aerification, seeding, and fertilization. With the seed, plugs and thatch laying around the greens it makes it a problem, not only for golfers, but also for machines mowing the greens and green banks so please be patient as we work through this process. Also may be additional irrigation to areas to maintain moisture on the young seedlings to help with germination, so carts may be controlled away from these areas with the GPS geo fencing.

Leaves will also be the hot topic in the next couple of months. We will our best to blow, mulch, and control the leaves as they begin to fall. This process is labor intensive as wind direction and conditions change dictating where we can and cannot move the leaves, too (not into homeowners' yards).
