



## From the General Manager


We start off this month with hopes that the April showers will start soon and mother nature will give us a little help with the green grasses of the course—and with more updates to the Clubhouse.

St. Andrew's Pub just has a few minor fixtures/décor options to select from before we call the project done, and we hope you will appreciate the updates we've made to both the look and feel. The hand-hewn walnut tabletops will be in place this month and will certainly be a highlight in terms of both usage and look for the Pub.

We await Board direction and approval for changes to the hallway running parallel to the Oaks Terrace deck, which will help with Argyle and Terrace efficiency. And speaking of the deck, we are projected to open for service on the deck early May. Though these projects have been long and at times slow undertakings they will be well worth the wait when we have a fabulous deck complete with a smokeless fire pit and accompanying seating area, Tropitone chairs and tables, and deck-exclusive menu offerings for you and your friends and family to enjoy after a round of golf on the course. We have ordered Tropitone umbrellas like we had at the end of last year,

but they are still ten weeks out. In the meantime, we will use new Sunvilla Umbrellas that we purchased from Costco. We will move these down to the patio when the Tropitone umbrellas come in.

We have finalized the design of the new 15 Station Synthetic Turf Driving Range. The Turf we will be using is the same material used in the Tomorrows Golf League (TGL). Installation should begin this month weather permitting.

Turf Tip

Aerification of the greens went well this year. As mentioned in last month's article, we wanted to move up the date from March 31 to March 24, which we did and I am happy about it. We caught the nice week of above average temperatures to promote the growing in of the holes. With that process behind us, we can focus on pre-emerging 100 acres of turf for



crabgrass. The goal is to use a liquid pre-emergent with fertilizer on 40 acres of fairway, tees, and green banks. Then spread a granular product on the rest of the roughs. This process does take some time, due to weather conditions.

Irrigation system pumps were energized and most section are full of water and operating now. We did have a few major leaks; there was a 10-inch main line between 18 green and 1 tee with a problem, and several sections valves that needed to be rebuilt so we could pressurize the system. As the system, ages there is consistently more and more issues during pressurization (UGH).
